There are two categories of participation in VFN: Members and Partners. Philanthropy is strengthened by both Member and Partner engagement, with Members who invest funding in communities and Partners who bring expertise and knowledge supporting the funding community. VFN is stronger with both types of participants as well. Membership for both categories runs on a calendar year.

Virginia Funders Network recognizes that many potential Members and Partners may also do fundraising as a normal course of their business. The expectation is that anyone engaged with VFN, including invited guests, will be respectful of VFN's Non-Solicitation Policy while participating in VFN events. Members and Partners must follow VFN's Non-Solicitation Policy. Dues payment is considered acknowledgement and acceptance of the policy.

Partner Qualifications

Organizations, businesses, and sole practitioners that serve the philanthropy/nonprofit field but are not grantmaking institutions may qualify as VFN Partners. Expanding our membership opens VFN Members to potential resource opportunities and Partners with potential business development opportunities. Completing this membership application and participating in an internal VFN approval process are required.

The Partner category includes:

- Think tanks, academic institutions, and other philanthropy serving organizations that focus the majority of their work on the philanthropic and nonprofit fields.
- Consultants who provide services in support of grantmaking organizations.
- Professional advisors who provide some services in support of grantmaking organizations and do not qualify to apply as a Member.

Sole Practitioner Partner (single membership): \$1,500 annually includes:

Virginia Funders Network Non-Solicitation Policy

The Virginia Funders Network provides a unique space and events where philanthropic leaders can gather, learn, share ideas, and seek the advice and input of their peers and colleagues. As such, at VFN events, solicitation, promotion, and fundraising of any kind to benefit a specific organization, event, or cause by members, partners, and/or guests is prohibited. This ensures a comfortable, respectful atmosphere in which professional relationships can be fostered and maintained. Notably, this shall not prohibit education, communication, and collaboration among funders for areas of mutual interest. Members understand that the CEO, Advisory Board members, and other VFN leadership, in their roles as fiduciaries, shall make members aware of funding opportunities that support VFN's strategic objectives.

The payment of dues by members and partners is acceptance of VFN's non-solicitation policy. Violators of this policy, as decided by VFN's Executive Committee, may be excluded from future VFN events and/or denied future membership.

VFN may invite representatives of the grantseeking community to join us as speakers, panelists, or guests at VFN events. We also ask these representatives to adhere strictly to our policy of non-solicitation. Invited nonprofit representatives who violate this policy, as decided by VFN's Executive Committee, may be excluded from future VFN events.
